
161 New Multilingual Learners 7/1 - 9/30/21

- 95 (59%) Portuguese speakers from Brazil

103 students arrived with their families from the border (FFB)

- 38 (24%) Spanish speakers from Central America (El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras)
 25 students from Central America are unaccompanied minors/youth from the border (UMB)
- 28 (17%) Multilingual from a variety of countries (Dominican Republic, Colombia, Haiti, India, Kuwait, Saudi Arabia, United Arab Emirates, and others)
- All new MLE enrollees have experienced disruption in schooling due to travel, COVID closures, or detention. 48 (30%) are considered SIFE/SLIFE entering school two are more years below grade level for their age.
