- Compliance review in regards to legal rights of students and families
- Legal responsibility of district to identify students' need for language services and to provide equity, access, and inclusion for multilingual learners
- Requirements of the law include parental informed consent and information about ongoing student progress (initial identification, quarterly, annually, and upon reclassification)
- Requirements of the law include ESL and meaningful access to content learning (SEI)

Castañeda Three-Pronged Test

- Included in TFM as Self Assessment
- Required as a result of a court decision to determine compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Equal Opportunities Act of 1974
- Requires that an ELE program
 - is based on a sound education theory or on research
 - is implemented with adequate and appropriate resources, and
 - results in demonstrable academic outcomes for ELs

MLE Strategies Based on Self Assessment

- Program articulation and alignment
- MLE Assessment and Placement: prepare for anticipated increase in new MLE students
- SLIFE identification and appropriate multilingual supports: Social, emotional, academic, and literacy
- Focus on curriculum, instruction, and Success Planning for students not making progress
- Expansion of dual language opportunities including curriculum materials and Sonrisa pre school
- Continue to build bilingual/dual language educator pipeline
