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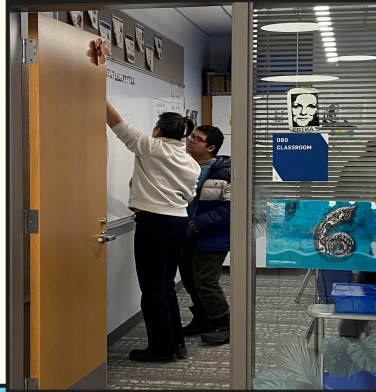
# Mission Statement

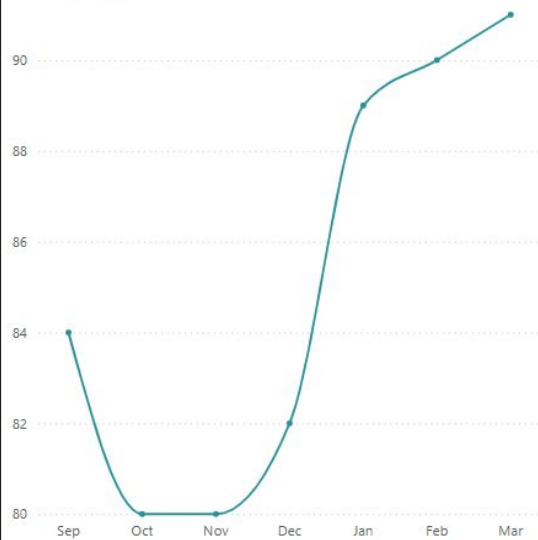

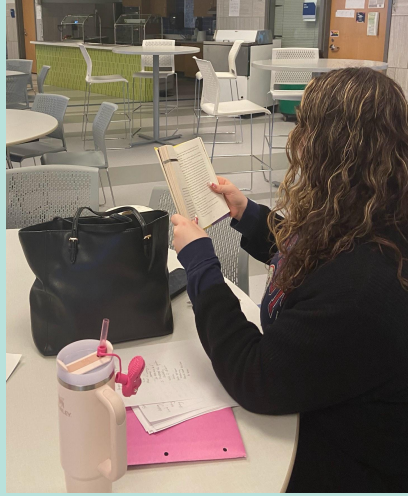

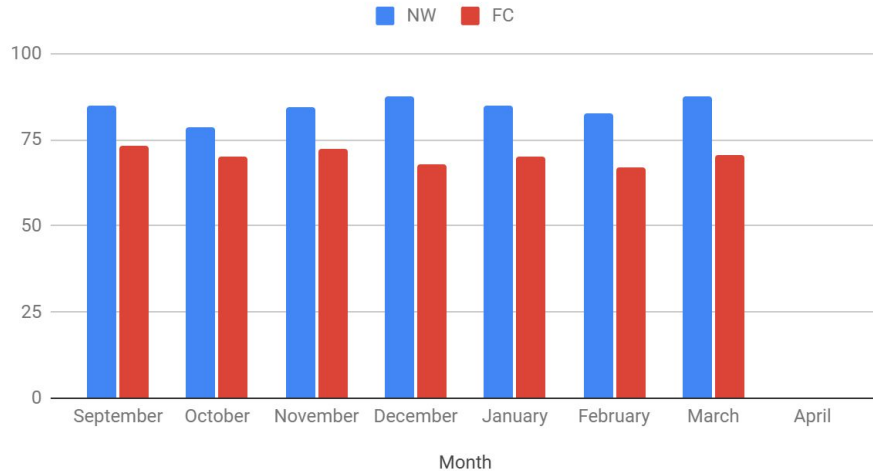

# Academic Data

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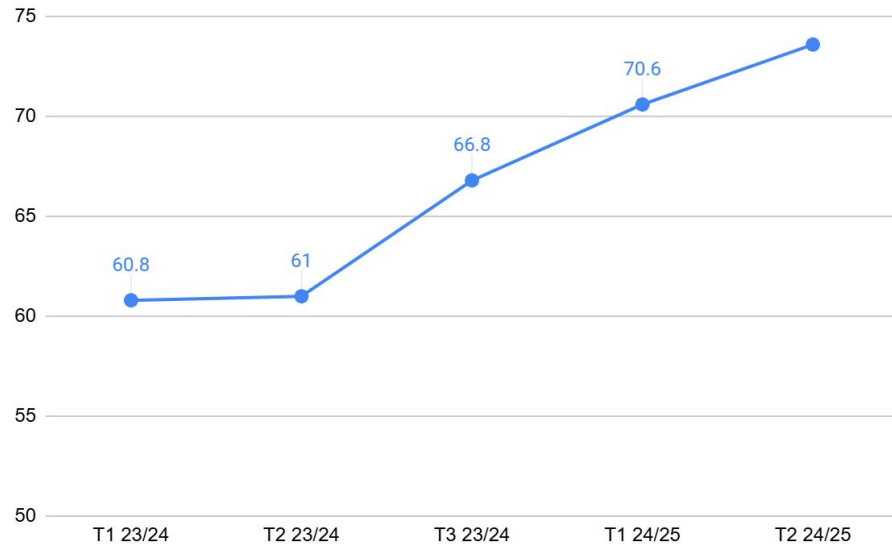
NW and FC

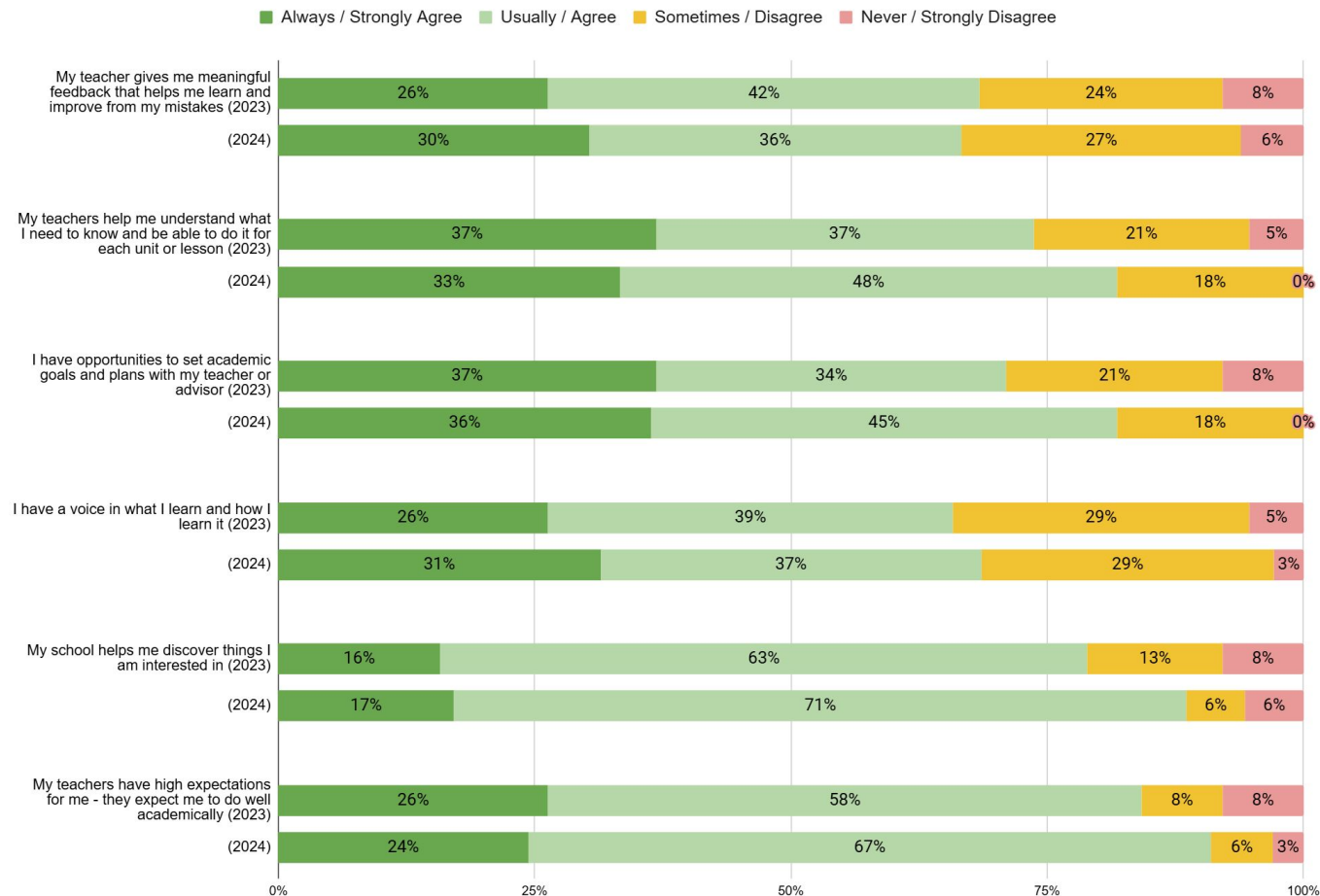
# Full Circle Classes Passed %

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## Goal:

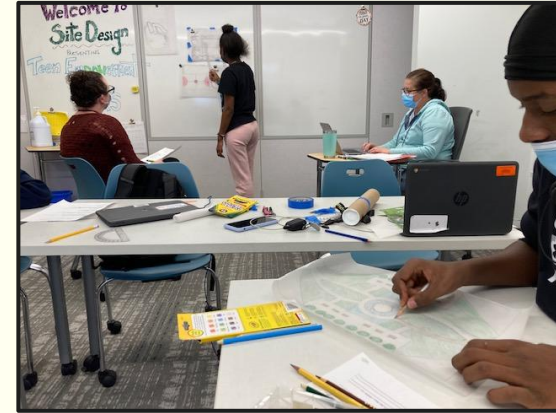
By June 2027, a portfolio system will be implemented and used as a measure for student's to reflect on their academic growth and understanding of the competencies.

Use student portfolios as a measure to see student progress & growth on competencies and a celebration of student work as they complete 8th and 12th grade.

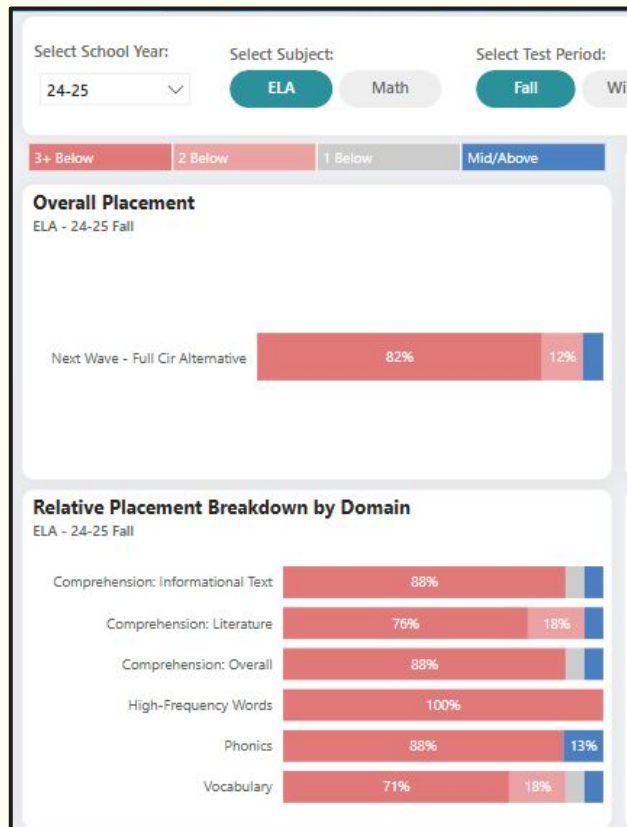

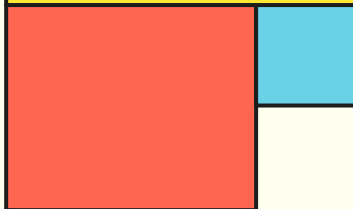

- ★ i-Ready Data:
  - 82% of NW students in grades 6-8 scoring 3+ grade levels below
  - Do not give i-Ready assessment at FC
    - 78% of 8th graders are 3+ grade levels below

- ★ IEP Data: Reading Goals and Reading support
  - 2 NW students
  - 8 FC students

# Equity Goal

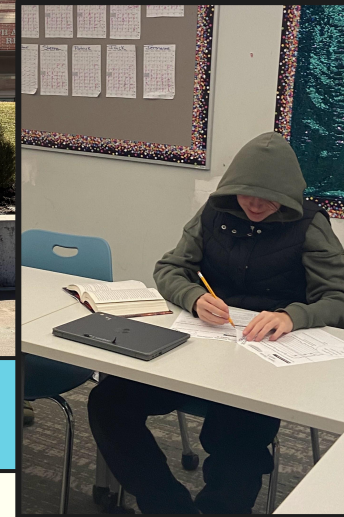
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## Goal

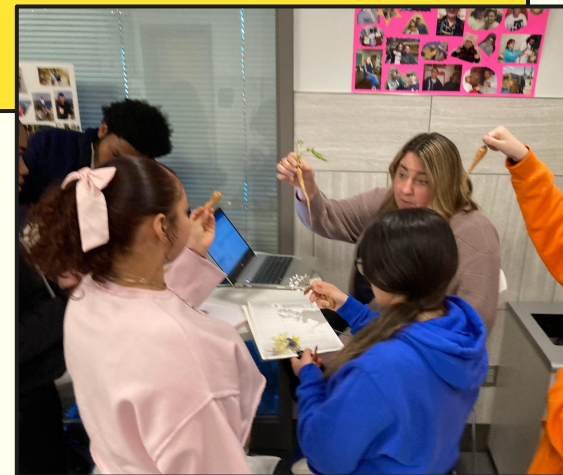
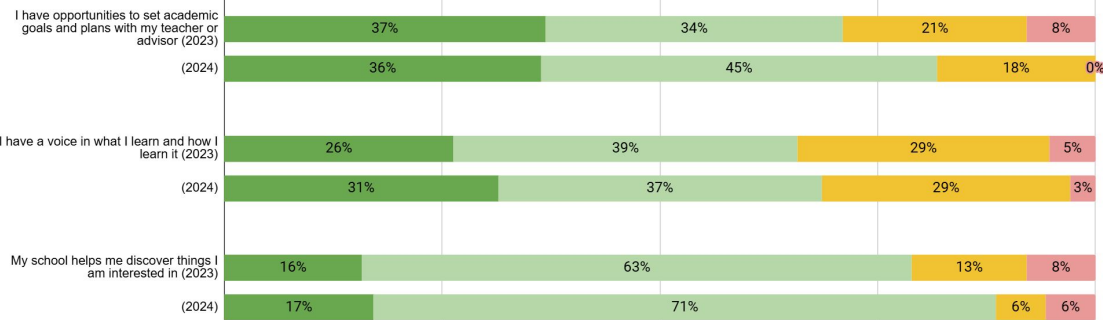
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## Student Responses to CFL Questions 2024

- Regular celebrations to recognize student contributions

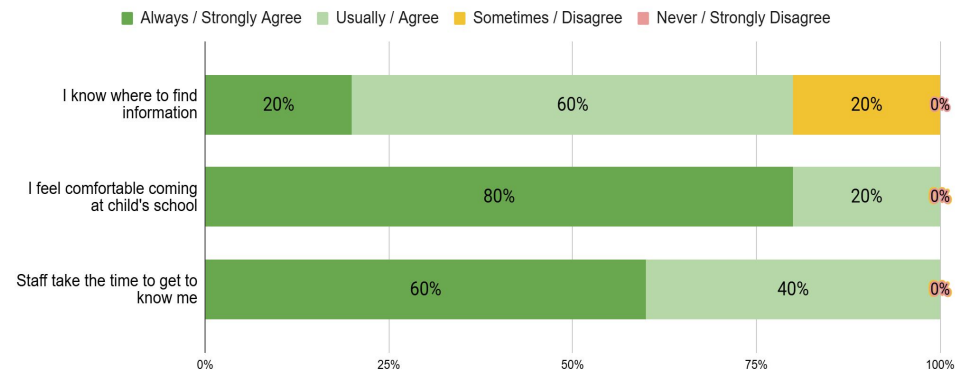

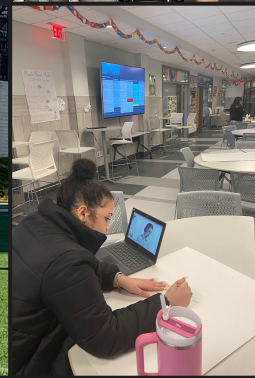
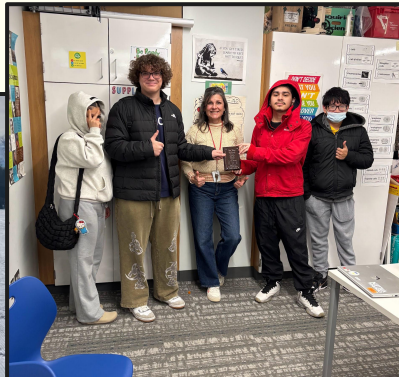
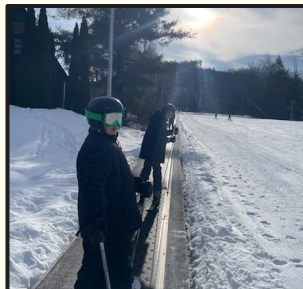
By June 2027, we will see an increase in parent engagement and their understanding of the academic program to strengthen the parent/guardian's role as academic partners.
