WHAT IS WOOD PELLET TURF?


- Wood Pellet Turf is a type of infill used in artificial turf fields.

- Wood Pellet Turf is also made from renewable wood sources.




ADDRESSING CONCERNS

- Installation is quite expensive
 The low cost of maintenance will help offset this over time.
- Artificial turf gets hot in the summer
- Wood pellets absorb less heat than rubber, helping the field temperature stay lower during hot days. There are also ways of cooling it down.
- It isn't good for the environment
- We will use eco friendly wood pellets to help this problem. And unlike a grass field, turf doesnt need chemical treatments.


Does your sport benefit from a turf field?




Would you use a turf field more often?
