SUMMER 2024 PROGRAMMING

- Offered 4 different CTE program for rising 6th, 7th & 8th grade students
 - Health Careers, Carpentry, Graphics & Culinary
 - 3 week program with 48 students enrolled
- Pre-Apprenticeship Program for Construction Trades (Mass)
- 18-22 year old program (9 week program)
 - 2 weeks in Carpentry, 1 week in Plumbing and Electrical

- Worked with the Office of College, Career, and Technical Education for approval of Full Circle students enrollment in the SHS CTE programs

COMMUNITY PROGRAMMING

- Cosmetology is open to the public on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10-1pm. The clinic has been averaging over 10 clients per day. Call 617-629-5250 x611550 to make an appointment.
- Automotive is open to the public and have been averaging 15-20 cars per week. Please fill out this form. <u>Automotive work request</u>
- Culinary has been open for take out to the high school on average 2-3 days a week. They had 2 Veteran Breakfasts with 40-50 Veterans in attendance. They have 7 more dates booked.



- Second Chance Cars is a Massachusetts 501c3 corporation that provides refurbished, affordable used cars to Eastern Massachusetts' low-income veterans and returning citizens. The cars allow their new owners a chance to obtain living-wage jobs and the ability to achieve their full potential.
- They work closely with some of the best social services agencies and nonprofits to help them select "car-ready" candidates. They also work with a network of vocational schools and automotive specialists who refurbish our donated vehicles professionally and affordably.
- Second chance cars will do a unveiling presentation with the recipient and the students right on school grounds. They also donate \$1000.00 in scholarship funds for Somerville HS Automotive graduating students.

- LGW will provide SHS CTE students with critical job skills & experience and help fill in any labor gaps within the DPW. This will be a Cooperative Education placement.
