


Enrollment has been relatively steady





PY SY 2025








New MLE Students by grade (as of 9/15/2024)




Different Languages (as of 9/15/2024)

Additional notes

- We enrolled 827 students this year since January 2024. 245 additional families decided not to attend or did not complete registration.
- 24.4% of all families requested in person assistance to enroll
- We approved 45 requests for transfer to a different PK-8 school
- We denied 22 requests for transfer due to space limitations
- We have 37 students on the PK waitlists for Argenziano, East, Kennedy and West
- We have 80 students on the K-8 waitlists across the district
- Families of 51 Pre-K students assigned to a school chose not to attend
 37 last year and 61 the year before
- We currently have:
 - 83 students designated as homeless (38 for SY 24, 50 for SY23)
 - 17 Students in foster care (21 for SY24 and 22 for SY 23)
 - 35 students are being monitored and supported through prevention services to avoid homelessness.
