Registration Information

All students who will be 5 years old by August 31, 2022 are invited to register for Kindergarten.

Online **Registration begins January 11, 2022 and you must register by March 18, 2022 to be eligible for the first round of assignments.** Please visit www.somerville.k12.ma.us/Kindergarten to begin. Have the following documentation and information available to facilitate the registration process:

- Your Child's Birth Certificate
- School/Camp Form (Medical) provided by your child's doctor's office and immunization information. More info: www.somerville.k12.ma.us/RegistrationHealth
- Health Insurance Card
- Doctor's Information/Dentist's Information – Name and Telephone Number for both
- If your child takes any medicine or has any medical condition/concerns need name of medicine/condition/concerns
- 2 Current Proofs of Residency. See attached document or find more info on the website: www.somerville.k12.ma.us/ResidencyRequirements
- 2 Emergency Contacts other than parent/guardian – Full Name, Relationship, Telephone #
- Your Email Address
- Your Working Cell Phone Number

If your child's first language is NOT English, an Enrollment Office Specialist will contact you to schedule an appointment for an English language proficiency assessment. Program recommendations and school assignments will NOT be made until after testing is complete.
