Questions of Equity

Somerville High School is committed to equity. We are continually reviewing our programs to look for gaps in opportunity, access, and experience, and work hard to redirect our efforts and systems to close those gaps. For athletics, we are looking at:

- 1. What does Somerville High School offer? (opportunity)
- 2. Who participates? (access)
- 3. How are resources allocated? (uniforms, practice and game schedule, quality and number of coaches, equipment)
- 4. What kind of experience are our athletes having?

NOTE: Data from Winter 2022-Fall 2023 was used to make this presentation

ACCESS - Monitoring Demographic Info and Removing Barriers

- Recent focus on removing barriers for MLE students, students whose parents speak a language other than English, and students who need better access to medical requirements
 - SHS Athletics utilizes several platforms for information and athlete registration. All platforms come with multiple languages of translation to better assist all families with having their children participate in athletics at SHS.
 - Providing drop in hours/assistance for registration with SFLC and MLE Counselor
 - Helping students get physicals and required vaccinations etc at CHA Teen Center
 - SHS is not a pay to play program, like many other high schools. There is no fee attached to participating in athletics at SHS.
- Set up system to monitor <u>participation</u> by <u>demographic information</u>
 - Will continue to work with students and families to reduce barriers for underrepresented groups
- Added Unified Sports Basketball Fall 2023; hoping to add Track and Field SY25



Teams with the highest percentage of....

- Latinx/Hispanic students: Cheerleading: 59.26%
- Black students: Boys Basketball 26.83%
- **Low-Income Students:** Girls' Basketball 48.6%, Cheerleading 48.18%, Football 47%
- **MLE Students:** Boys Soccer 27%
- White Students: Golf 88.89%
- **Greatest participation by female-identifying athletes on:** Soccer (55)



Data indicates equitable distribution of resources - uniforms, facilities, coaches

- Boys' and Girls' teams get equal practice time during the duration of their season
- Times alternate so that no one program gets a "better" time (ie Boys' Basketball practices 6-8pm and Girls' Basketball practices 4-6 pm for one week and the next week they switch time slots)
- Boys' and Girls' teams have an equal number of home and away games
- All teams get new uniforms every four years (note club sports fundraise for their own uniforms)
- Some sports have higher equipment/uniform costs (ie football, softball, baseball, hockey)
- Every year we host speakers for ALL athletes
- Equal access to all facilities in Somerville, (Fields, Weight Room, etc.)

Note on other sources of funding

- All teams fundraise and \$ are deposited in the Student Activities Accounts
- All 'extra" gear and equipment are purchased with this money
- Booster Clubs (501 3cs not run by school) exist for Track, Cross Country,
 Boy's Basketball, Hockey they fundraise for additional gear and
 equipment
- All Club sports fundraise for uniforms and equipment and tournament fees; School provides paid coaches, some transportation, access to facilities and trainer, and occasional assistance on other costs
