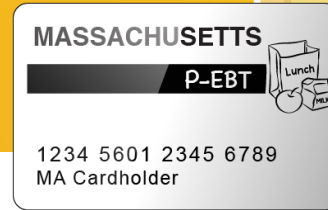


September P-EBT

Food Funds for Families during COVID-19



What is P-EBT?

The Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer (P-EBT) program provides food funds for families during the COVID-19 pandemic at a rate of \$5.86 per day.

Who will get P-EBT for September?

Families will get P-EBT for each eligible student who qualifies for free or reduced-price meals under the National School Lunch Program, AND

- The school building has been closed due to a delayed start AND/OR
- The student is learning at home for at least 5 days in a row.

P-EBT benefits are available to households regardless of immigration status and are not considered in a public charge test.

How and when will I get the funds?

If you get SNAP or TAFDC benefits:

Check your EBT card for P-EBT funds starting September 30

If you got a P-EBT card in the past:

Check your P-EBT card for P-EBT funds starting September 30

If you do not have SNAP/ TAFDC and never got a P-EBT card:

You will get a P-EBT card and DTA letter separately in the mail in October. Keep your letter to pin your card!

What if I no longer have my P-EBT card?

Request a new one at www.DTAconnect.com/PEBT starting October 1.

What can I buy?

You can buy food items like fruits, meats/poultry/fish, dairy and breads. Use P-EBT at stores that accept SNAP, like grocery stores or corner stores, and online at Amazon or Walmart.

Need more food help?

If you get P-EBT you are likely eligible for SNAP, a monthly food benefit. Apply at www.DTAconnect.com. P-EBT supplements school meals. Visit www.meals4kids.org to find a meal site near you.
