ELA	In the 2024 - 2025 School Year, we rolled out a new English Language Arts curriculum in grades 6, 7, and 8 called Fishtank ELA. The guiding principles for Fishtank are: Building knowledge to nurture critical thinking. Centering diverse, relevant, and rigorous texts. Prioritizing student voices and ideas to build agency. Math	In grades K-8, we use the <i>Illustrative Mathematics</i> (IM) curriculum. IM Math is a problem-based core curriculum rooted in content and practice standards to foster learning and achievement for all. Students learn by doing math, solving problems in mathematical and real-world contexts, and constructing arguments using precise language. Information for families is available online in both English and Spanish.
Science	In 6 th grade science, we use a curriculum called <u>STEMScopes</u> , which is aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards and the MA Curriculum Frameworks.
Social Studies	8th grade social studies follows the 2018 MA History and Social Science Framework. The year focuses on American Government and civics, and it culminates with the 8th grade civics project.
